



# VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR AUTISM DIAGNOSIS RESEARCH STUDY



Researchers from Rutgers University are recruiting children and their parents or caregivers for a research study assessing the utility of a diagnostic interview for autism evaluations.

## **In order to participate in this research study, children should:**

- Be seeking a diagnostic evaluation for Autism Spectrum Disorder OR have a previous diagnosis of ASD.
- Be between 10 years old to 17 years old.
- Have a parent/caregiver who can provide information about the child's development and current behavior and experiences.

## **What is involved in participation?**

- Children will complete questionnaires (if able) and one 2-3 hour diagnostic evaluation.
- Parents/caregivers will complete questionnaires and *two* 2-4 hour interviews.
- A 1-hour feedback session to review test results.

## **What do participants receive?**

Families who complete the study will receive a brief written summary of results from their assessment and a \$75 gift card.

## **Where does the study take place?**

- Child visits will take place on the Rutgers University campus at:
  - Nelson Building (604 Allison Road; Piscataway, NJ) *or*
  - RCAAS Psychological Services Clinic (100 Dudley Road; New Brunswick, NJ)
- Parent/caregiver interviews can take place at locations above or via teleconference
