WHAT

An eye-tracking study to learn more about how bilingual adults with autism process language in real time. Participants will complete questionnaires, language proficiency tasks, and computer-based tasks -- responding with button presses on the keyboard while their eye movements are tracked. The study will take **one hour** over one session.

Spanish-English bilingual adults 18 – 30 years old who have received a professional diagnosis of autism.
