

Seeking Parent Volunteers for a Research Study

What is this study about?

VCU researchers are looking to learn more about suicide risk screening practices for youth on the autism spectrum, including caregiver experience and perspectives on screening autistic youth for suicide symptoms.

The team will use the information we learn to develop educational materials about suicide risk in autism for caregivers and clinicians.

Who can participate?

Caregivers of children and adolescents aged 7-17 years old with an autism diagnosis who live in New York or Virginia.

What will I be asked to do?

You will be asked to complete an online survey, which includes questions about your child's diagnoses and mental health history, the services you have used to support your child, and your perspectives on suicide risk screening practices for autistic youth.

The survey will not require you to share any identifying information and will take about 20-30 minutes. At the end of the survey, you will be given the opportunity to provide your e-mail address to enter a drawing for a chance to win a \$50 Amazon gift card.
